



Tumaren Camp - Laikipia

NO 27.194 E36 57. 444

Tumaren Camp is located on a 10,000 acre conservancy within the larger conservation and community area of Laikipia.

The camp faces south west and overlooks a wide open plain with a waterhole and salt lick in front of the camp.

Each group has their own guide throughout the stay.

Facilities:

Main sitting room with its own toilet

Main Dining room

Private dining and sitting room - Tent 8 - for those wanting to eat alone / families

Tent 6 & 7 Can be taken separately with Tent 8 as their own dining and sitting room

20 metre swimming pool with a large pool house and bar and changing room with toilet.

Meals can be enjoyed here as well as the other two dining rooms

Shop

Private airstrip - walking distance to the camp

Wifi - at our offices in a guests wifi tent. 200 metres from the pool house. None in the main camp

Accommodation

7 large en suite safari tents with verandas - 3 to the left of the communal area and 4 to the right.

4 tents have dividers for extra privacy if needed.

Private entrances to each tent

Each can have beds added to then including a baby cot.

Solar lighting with flush toilets and hot running water at all times.

Tent 1. Tent with a divider: Double bed and a single bed

Tent 2. Double bed

Tent 3. Double bed and 2 singles - open plan

Tent 4: Double

Tent 5: Family tent with a divider - Double bed, twin beds and an extra day bed if needed

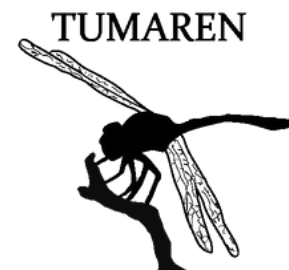
Tent 6: Family tent with a divider - Double bed, twin beds

Tent 7: Family tent with a divider - Double bed, twin beds and an extra day bed if needed

Extras:

Nanny at an extra cost

Mountain biking - on request and availability

**Activities:**

Guests to plan daily with their guide - there is an information pack in each tent and communal area.

Guided walks of all lengths with an armed ranger

Camel rides

Visiting the camel creche

Day and night game drives

Top Rope Climbing on a choice of rocks from beginner to advanced - trained guides and equipment included

Swimming in the 20 metre pool or else the river for paddling

Getting to Tumaren:

Private charter to Tumaren airstrip -2 mins drive / walking distance to camp

Schedule flights: Loisaba - 1.5 hours and Nanyuki 2.5 hours

Drive: 2 hours from Nanyuki and 6 hours from Nairobi

What wildlife can you see?

Mammals: Guenther's Dikdik, Steinbuck, Klipspringer, Thompson's Gazelle, Grant's Gazelle, Gerenuk, Impala, Highland Hartebeest, Beisa Oryx, Waterbuck, Eland, Bushbuck, Lesser Kudu, Reticulated Giraffe, Elephant, Common Zebra, Grevy's Zebra, Hippo, Lion, Leopard, Cheetah, Caracal, Serval Cat, Wildcat, Spotted Hyena, Striped hyena, Aardwolf, Wilddog, Black-backed Jackal, Bat-eared Fox, White-tailed Mongoose, Dwarf Mongoose, Slender-tailed Mongoose, Genet Cat, Bushbaby, Aardvark, Porcupine, Baboon, Vervet Monkey, Yellow-winged Bat.

Birds: A sample of the many we see: Ostrich, Kori Bustard, Heuglin's Courser, Von Der Decken's Hornbill, White-bellied Go-away Bird, Vitelline Masked Weaver, Spotted Thickknee, Rosy-patched Bushshrike, Eastern Chanting Goshawk, Tawny Eagle, Bateleur Eagle, Marico Sunbird, Red-fronted Warbler, Rufous Chatterer, D'Arnaud's Barbet, Straw-tailed Whydah, Yellow-necked Spurfowl, Speckled pigeon, Grey Headed Bushshrike, Egyptian Goose, Fan Tailed Raven

Reptiles and Amphibians: Garmani Toad, Bubbling Kassina, Cryptotis Sandfrog, Picturatus Dwarf Gecko, Brooks Gecko, Variable Skink, Red-headed Agama, Elementaita Agama, Long-tailed Lizard, Side-striped Chameleon, Brown Spitting Cobra, Puff adder, Rufous Beaked Snake, Side-striped Sand Snake, Leopard Tortoise.
